

Easter Garden

You can write your own version of the story or produce a cartoon strip of the Easter Story. Please ask if you would like help with this.

In church every year there is an Easter garden to show the tomb where Jesus was laid, maybe a symbol of the cross Jesus was crucified on along with flower, stones etc.

We would like you to make your own Easter garden. This can be as large or small as you wish and you can take pictures for your class and put on class dojo or add to your portfolio.

If you are unsure, then here are some ideas:

- Use a plant pot tray – and put some soil in it. Collect some stones, grass, flowers, twigs etc from the garden and then use to create your garden. It should have a tomb with the stone across it. You could include a cross as a symbol if you wish, or create some people to be Mary and Jesus in the garden on Easter Day.
- Use play dough to create people and the tomb – or something similar.
- Make paper or card flowers.
