# KEY STAGE 2 STRIVE FOR EXCELLENCE WITH THE LAUNCH OF NEW TIMES TABLE AWARDS



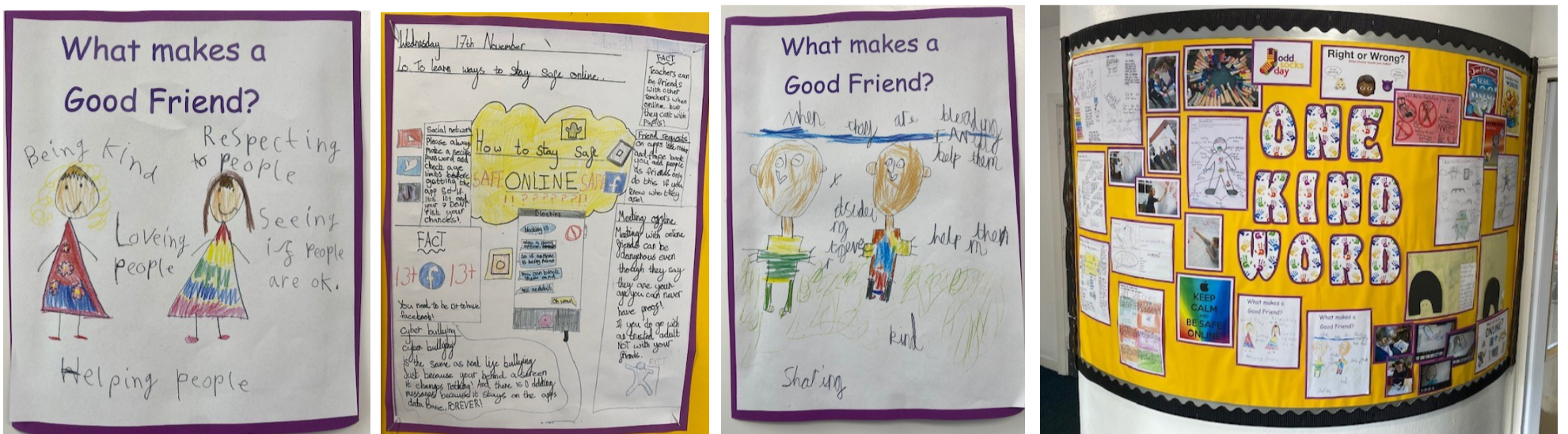
