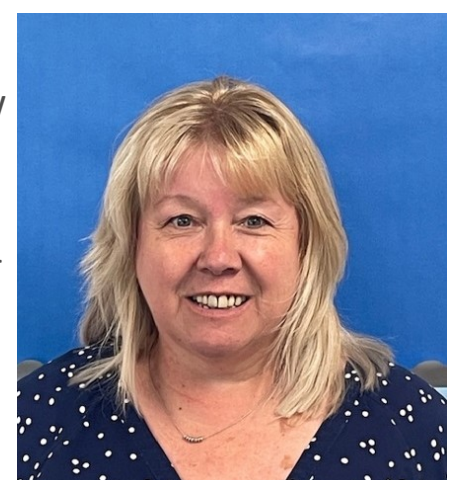

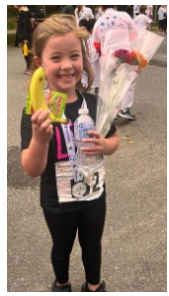
## Worship Leads Strive for Kindness

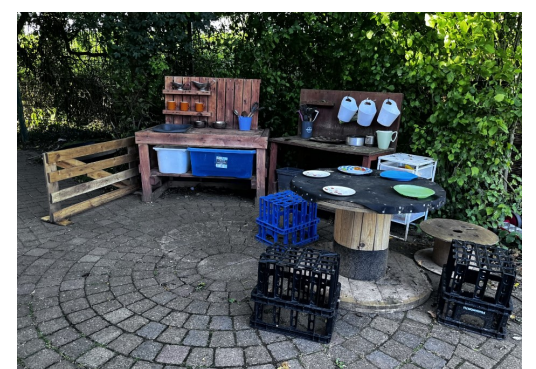
