The Pupil Asset Parent app is now available for all parents with pupils currently attending the school. It is our intention to use this app/portal to bring you a step closer to your child's schooling.

Logging on for the first time

If it is your first time using the app, tap First Login/Forgot Password, then enter the email address that the school has on record for you. When you tap Submit, we will send you an email which will allow you to set your password. You need to inform your school if your email address has changed. You will be asked to set a four digit PIN before you login. The home screen of the app will show any pupils on Pupil Asset where your email address has been given online access. If your child does not show, please contact the school office as they may need to update your child's record.

Features

Payments – Make payments for specific trips, clubs or items, top up your school meal balance and see your payment history.

Attendance – Shows attendance for the year as well as giving you the ability to log absences.

School information – View contact information for your child's school.

Events – View, give consent, book in to any upcoming events your child is set as attending.

Settings – Update the information your child's school holds for you.

We are intending to include more features in time, but this will only be feasible to ALL households sign up. Don't forget you will need to register with Pupil Asset in order to book a parent consultation appointments on the 8th and 9th February.


STILL LIFE DRAWING TECHNIQUES
